**Uniform Policy Reminders**

Thanks to all students/parents who adhere to the uniform policies at SJP and STA! Please take the time to review the uniform policies (found in the *Parent/Teacher Handbook* on the website) with your children again. At this time of year we find the children are sometimes lax in adhering to the policies.

A few trouble spots are the following: 1) girls' jumpers/skirts/skortis are short and hems need to be dropped or new ones purchased at the right length; 2) boys' haircuts are too long and need to be cut more frequently; 3) girls' earrings are not the gold or silver ball required; 4) girls may not wear makeup or nail polish; and 5) both boys' and girls' shirts must be tucked in at all times (rolling the hem is not a substitute for the shirt being tucked in). Thank you for your help with the adherence to these policies.
