St. John Primary social studies program is guided by Houghton Mifflin. The first grade social studies curriculum includes the following five main concepts: People Everywhere (families and communities), Where We Live (earth and natural resources), World of Work (goods and services), Everything Changes (past and present), and Good Citizenship (laws and government). The main concepts in second grade are: People and Places (communities), Places Near and Far (regions and resources), Ways of Living (sharing cultures), People at Work (needs and wants), America's Past (explorers and past heroes), and America's Government (laws and leaders). Enrichment activities are utilized to reinforce the program.

The social studies curriculum correlates to Louisiana Grade-Level Expectations (GLEs) along with the National Standards.
