- *Refreshments

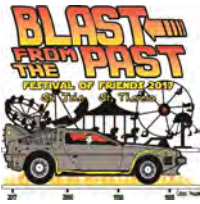
MINI-POT JAMBALAYA COOK-OFF (for students grades PK-12th)
