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## **St. John Primary/St. Theresa Middle 2018 FAIR WORK REQUIREMENT October 5, 6, 7, 2018**

*The Resident Board of Pastors & the Advisory School Board, the governing body of St. John Primary and St. Theresa Middle School, has authorized one mandatory fundraiser for the school to address the gap between the true cost of educating a student versus the tuition charged for education. This fund raiser is mandatory as all families benefit from the revenue in the form of education for their child(ren).*

### **The Fair Work Requirement is as follows:**

1. Each family must work Ten (10) clock hours of specific work at the Festival of Friends.\*
2. **Two** of the required 10 hours may be obtained via the following three choices. Only two options may be chosen:
  - a. Two (2) hours are given for a \$200.00 cash donation to the Auction Gala, turned in by Wednesday, September 5, 2018 by check made payable to EA/EI Partnership, or using PayPal within Signup Genius.
  - or**
  - b. One (1) hour credit is given for a cash donation of \$100.00 to the Country Store, turned in by Wednesday, September 5, 2018, either by check made payable to EA/EI Partnership, or using PayPal within Signup Genius, OR an item with a \$50-\$100 value to be turned in on Wednesday, September 19, 2018 in Room 27 on the STA Campus. The item must be a **new** sellable item to be verified by the Country Store Committee.
  - and/or**
  - c. One (1) hour credit is given for a home-baked contribution (2 dozen items of baked goods or 1 whole cake). All items are to be homemade and individually wrapped, including cupcakes. Items must be in non-returnable containers and labeled to identify them (type of cookie, flavor of cake, frosting filling).
3. Festival of Friends work sign up is completed online using a seniority method, meaning 8th grade families sign up first, 7th grade, etc. Each grade will have 24 hours to login and complete sign up for their family. Instructions are given to parents in Back to School night packets. Each family must sign up for the required amount of hours. Pre-assigned families have duties based on the work needed, which may require more than 10 working hours. Failure to sign up for festival hours will result in payment of the fee option (\$1,000.00 per student). If partial hours are worked during the Festival of Friends, parents will be billed \$100 per work hours missed by deducting their FACTS account on November 1, 2018.
4. Each family is required to sell raffle tickets valued at \$50.00 (given to parents in Back to School Night packets). Please collect all monies and write one check for \$50.00 made payable to EA/EI Partnership. The deadline to turn in raffle ticket stubs and money is Wednesday, September 19, 2018; however, these may be turned in at any time. Failure to turn in raffle tickets by the due date listed will result in this amount to be deducted from families' FACTS account on November 1, 2018.
5. Children under 18 are NOT allowed in booths at any time (with the exception of service workers), even when parents/family members are working required hours. Money booths require workers 21 years or older.
6. The Festival of Friends work records are the official records used to validate family requirement. **The Fair Committee has the right to re-assign any parent while or during the fair as needed. These requests are only made when we are short-handed in areas and need assistance. Your cooperation is most appreciated.**

*\*The student's primary address determines household status and the household determines family plan for both Festival of Friends and tuition.*
